<p><b>Dr.B.Prathusha Laxmi, HoD of AI&amp;DS Department</b> presented the summary of AI&amp;DS department. The Odd semester academic result was 100 % .. A total of 3 publications in scopus and WoS journals and Rs. One lakh granted for seminar. One Lakh received through consultancy project. She also presented their department's Action plan. Ensured that the digital material and video lectures for the Odd semester of the next Academic Year 2022-2023 would be uploaded on or before 30<sup>th</sup> July 2022. The target for Academic results and placements for the next Odd semester was presented. She also requested the UHV trained S&amp;H faculty members to prepare digital material for UHV subject.</p>	<p>Dean insisted the department to update the material for the upcoming academic year and asked to take extra effort for new subjects. He also asked to conduct activity based learning programs for students.</p>

<p><b>CSE Department:</b>  <b>Dr.M.Vigilson Prem,Professor of CSE department</b> presented the summary of the CSE Department. The Odd semester academic result was 99.43 % and the placement record was 95.19% with one student got highest package of 25Lpa.. A total of 45 publications in scopus and WoS journals. Three patents were published and one granted. Submitted 2 project proposals and 6 event proposals and received Rs.30000/- from Anna University for the event Artificial Intelligence. Many Industry Institute activities have been conducted. Webinars and FDPs were also conducted. Participation of faculty and students in events such as NPTEL, Coursera, Udemy and etc.,is encouraged. The target for Academic results and placements for the next Odd semester was presented.</p>	<p>Principal and Dean appreciated for having got good academic and placement record and appreciated the team for placing a student with a package of 25 Lakh per annum.  Dean sir pointed out that no Consultancy projects was done during 2021-22 and to work for it in the coming years.</p>
<p><b>ECE Department:</b>  <b>Dr.N.Gangatharan, HoD</b> presented the summary of the ECE Department. The Odd semester result was 99.13 %and the placement record was 95.42 %. The department has 64 publications in Scopus and WoS indexed journals. 13 patents were published. Submitted 8 project proposals and 26 event proposals,Through consultancy, total amount of Rs. 1,67,900 was received. Many Industry Institute activities have been conducted. Webinars and FDPs were also conducted. Participation of faculty and students in events such as NPTEL, Coursera, Udemy, NIITTR modules and etc., The target for the Academic results and placements in the Odd semester of the upcoming year was presented.</p>	<p>Principal and Dean appreciated for having got good academic and placement record and appreciated the department for placing a student with a package of 25 Lakh per annum  Dean suggested applying for AICTE and ISTE awards for Students and Faculty.  He also suggested to conduct more number of guest lectures for students and it can be a minimum of 2 per subject.</p>

**EEE Department:**

**Dr. N. Kalaiarasi HoD** presented the summary of the EEE Department. The Odd semester result was 100% and the placement record was 96.3%. A total of 9 publications by faculty members in scopus and WoS journals. Three patents were published. TNSCST Student Project received Rs.7500/-The department has received Rs.20,000/- for consultancy project. Many webinars have been organized in connection with Industry Institute interaction. The target for the next semester was presented.

**Mechanical Engineering Department:**

**Dr.M.Balasubramanian, HoD of Mechanical department** presented the summary of the Mechanical Engineering Department. The Odd semester result was 85.71% and the placement record was 84.33 %. A total of 55 journal publications by faculty members in scopus and WoS journals. Four patents were published and 3 granted. An amount of Rs. 1.6lakhs was received through consultancy.Many Industry Institute activities have been conducted. The target for the next semester was presented.

**Science and Humanities Department:**

**Dr. Selvakumaran, HoD** of S&H department presented the summary of the Science and Humanities Department. The Odd semester result was 82.56 %. A total of 23 publications were made in WoS and scopus indexed journals and Rs. 2, 00,000 was received through consultancy project. Eight patents were published. First year students have published papers

<p><b>Presentation by Overall Training and Placement Cell Coordinator:</b></p> <p>The Placement Coordinator <b>Mr. V. Mr. K.V. Sai Rakesh/ECE and Ms. R. Goldy Jeyarani/CSE of 2018-22 batch were placed in Amazon with the salary package of Rs. 25 Lakhs per annum.</li> <li>• For the 2019-2023 Batch, 76 students are placed with salary more than 5 LPA.</li> <li>• Campus interviews were organized in Physical mode in the College Campuses.</li> <li>• Webinars were organized for each Centers of Excellence to bridge Academia-Industry gap.</li> </ul>	<p>Dean suggested the Training and Placement Coordinator to conduct meetings with Department Coordinators to discuss and identify the students to be placed with higher packages</p> <p>Dean insisted that the Counsellors should mentor the students who are yet to be placed.</p>
<p><b>Dean Research</b>, appreciated all for the intense efforts taken to achieve good academic and placement records. He congratulated College NIRF Coordinator and all department coordinators for NIRF ranking that we have jumped 50 places forward and insisted that our next target must be below 200 band. He told that from next year onwards, parameters namely, Entrepreneurship and Innovation may be included in NIRF Ranking. He congratulated Two of our students who got placement offer with highest package of 25LPA.He also conveyed that our Chairman and Vice Chairman were happy about this and wished for more number of placements in higher packages in the years to come.</p>	<p>All HoDs ensured that all our goals would be achieved soon and would join hands together for reaching the Institutional Vision.</p>

Dean expressed that all departments should work in improving the count of Entrepreneur by motivating the students. He instructed the department Heads to conduct CO-PO awareness program for the newly joined faculty members. Also instructed to approach professional societies to build a strong technical bond also to improve the Industry Institution Interaction.

He also insisted that we should create an environment in such a way, student learn on their own way and come out with good outcomes for which we should find out the steps to motivate and encourage students through counsellors.

He insisted all the HoDs to make arrangements to educate the junior faculty members in the selection of journals while publishing their research articles. Also, He insisted that the faculty members must publish books in reputed publishing companies. He also shared that Our Vice Chairman is very meticulous in research aspect, expecting more publications in reputed journals and that patents must be worked out for moving towards commercialization. Finally, He concluded that all members of RMKCET to work as a team and succeed in all our goals.
