<p>CSE Department: Ms. S. Vaishnavi presented the summary of the CSE Department. The Odd semester academic result was 87% and the placement record was 86%. The department has received funding for Consultancy service for an amount of Rs.60,000. A total of 48 publications in scopus and WoS journals. Two patents were published and one granted. Rs. 3,93,000 funding received for projects and events from external funding sources. Many Industry Institute activities have been conducted. Webinars and FDPs were also conducted. Third year students have received second prize in virtual Hackathon internship Award.</p>	<p>Principal and Dean appreciated for having got good academic and placement record.</p>
<p>ECE Department: Ms. S Sesha Vidhya presented the summary of the ECE Department. The Odd semester result was 82.09 % and the placement record was 87.7 %. Many Industry Institute activities have been conducted. The department has 49 publications in Scopus and WoS indexed journals. Third Year students won 1st Prize with cash award of Rs.1 LAKH in Smart India Hackathon Hardware Edition 2020 Grand Finale organized by MHRD. A total amount of Rs. 3,43,667 was received for organizing events. Through consultancy, total amount of Rs. 2,52,000 was received.</p>	

EEE Department:

Dr. T.J. Catherine presented the summary of the EEE Department. The Odd semester result was 84.07% and the placement record was 81.03%. A total of 20 publications by faculty members in scopus and WoS journals. The department has received Rs.20,000 for consultancy project. A total amount of Rs, 25.00,000 funding received for MODROBS and STTP. Many webinars have been organized in connection with Industry Institute interaction.

Mechanical Engineering Department:

Dr. Bibin presented the summary of the Mechanical Engineering Department. The Odd semester result was 79.12% and the placement record was 78.3 %. A total of 57 journal publications by faculty members in scopus and WoS journals. 21 patents published and 2 granted. An amount of Rs. 2,73,800 was received through consultancy and Rs. 5,19,000 for various projects. Rs.6,60,000 received for funded events. II-year students received ISTE Best Student award 2020. III Year mechanical branch students are winners of Toycathon 2021 Digital Edition. Many Industry Institute activities have been conducted.

Science and Humanities Department:

Dr. K. Sudhakar presented the summary of the Science and Humanities Department. The Odd semester result was 85.42 %. A total of 41 publications in which 34 comes under scopus indexed journals and 7 comes under WoS indexed journals and Rs. 2,00,000 received through consultancy project. One patent was granted. First year students have published papers in WoS and Scopus publications including conference publications.
